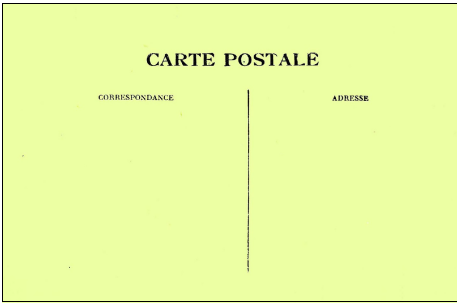


PASTEUR INSTITUTE POSTCARDS

ALGERIA

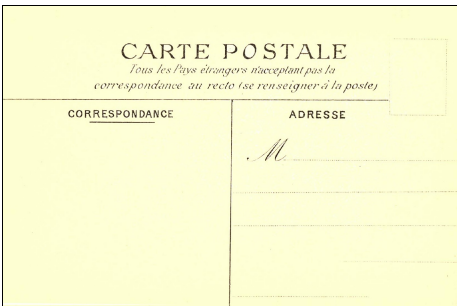
Under the direction of Doctors Edmond and Etienne Sergent of the Pasteur Institute of Algeria, the Algerian Health Service produced postcards promoting malaria control and prevention. Issued in the 1900s in several series, the cards describe malaria transmission, prevention, and prophylaxis. Three distinct groups of cards can be identified based on the appearance of their address-message side, listed below as types A, B, and C. Numbering includes an indicator of reverse type followed by a number for the front image. Since some of the front images are found on more than one type of reverse, each will have a discrete number. Drs. Sergent is inscribed in small print on the front of most cards. Thus far, the editors have not received a complete listing of types and front images.

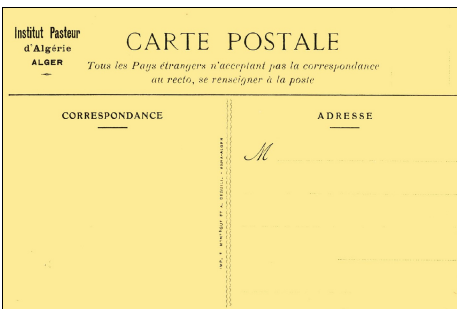

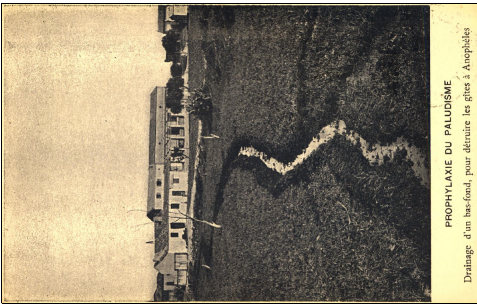

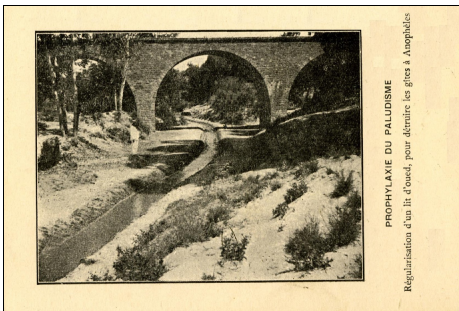

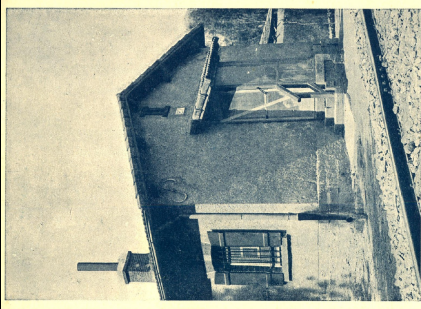

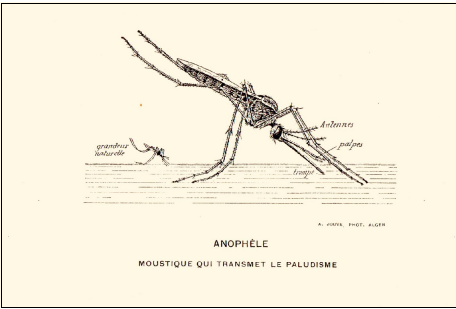


Image: *Anopheles* species

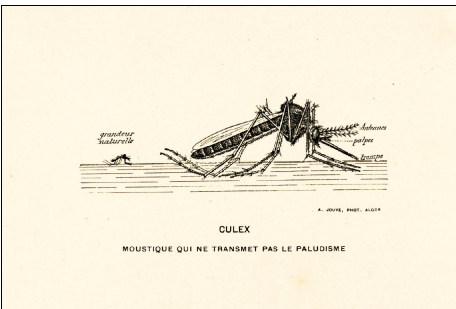


Image: *Culex* species

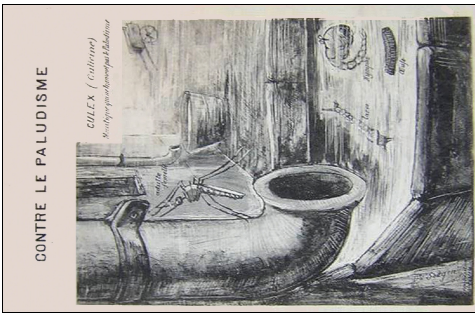


Image: water trough with *Culex* species

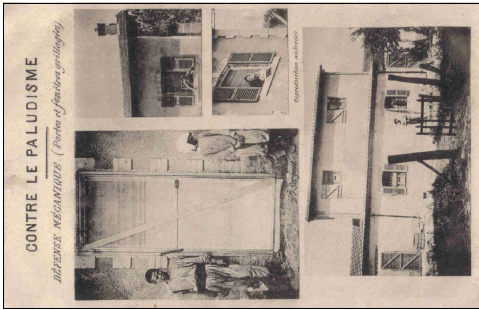


Image: views of house with screens on windows and doors

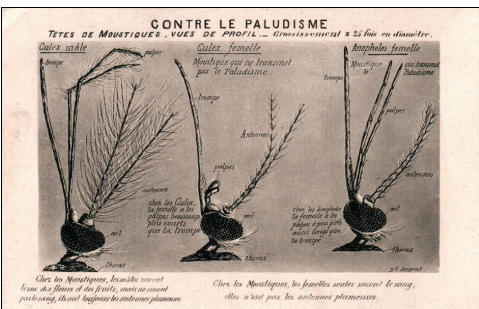


Image: heads of mosquitoes: *Culex* (male - female) and *Anopheles*

Text: identification of head parts followed by Males suck from flowers and fruits, but do not suck blood. They always have feathery antennae; Only the females suck blood. They do not have feathery antennae (at bottom)

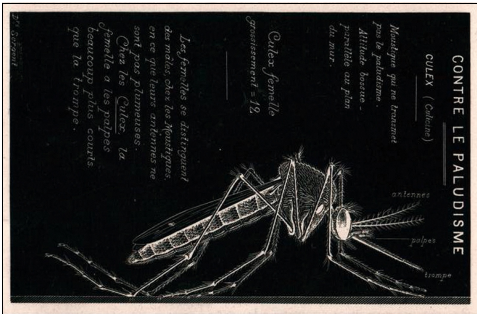


Image: mosquito identification: *Culex* sp.

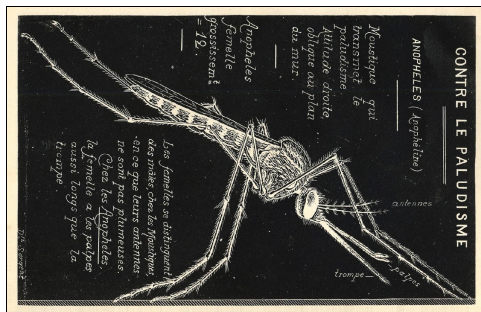


Image: mosquito identification: *Anopheles* sp.

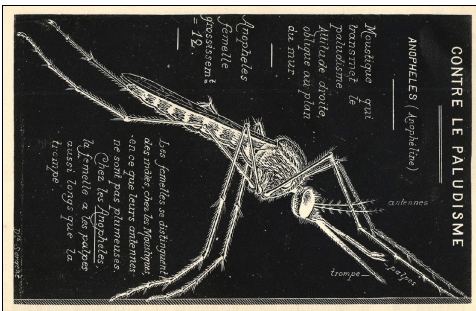


Image: mosquito identification: *Culex* sp.

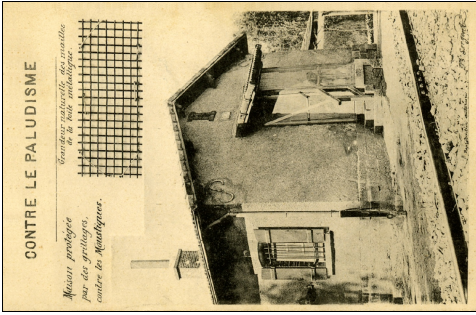


Image: screen applications

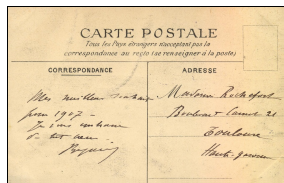

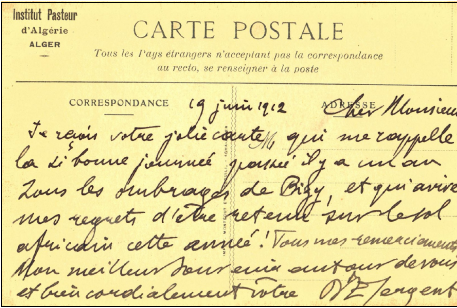

- Indigenous fellahs.

- A mosquito pond.

- A settler who settles next door.

This is the summary of the conditions necessary for the spread of malaria.

- The mosquito that stings a fellah paludeen takes, with the blood, the microbe which is there.

- If this mosquito then stings a settler, he inoculates, with his venom, the microbe of malaria.
