Ces neuf États membres de l'Organisation Mondiale de la Santé émettront au cours de l'année 1962 un timbre pour appuyer la campagne d'éradication du paludisme dans le monde entier.

Le paludisme est encore fort répandu dans de nombreuses régions du globe puisqu'on a pu estimer qu'il y a plus d'un milliard de personnes qui y sont exposées, en particulier dans les zones tropicales et marécageuses. Si la maladie n'est pas spectaculaire, elle n'en occupe pas moins durablement les populations touchées : de nombreux pays étaient et sont encore atteints dans leur capacité de production. La mise en valeur et les transformations indispensables de certaines zones se heurtent ainsi à ce problème...
A la fin du XX^e siècle, les épidémies d'encelées ont décimé les équipes d'ouvriers et d'ingénieurs qui s'efforçaient d'ouvrir le canal de Panama. L'entreprise ne peut être menée à bien qu'après l'établissement complet, par des moyens techniques employés à grande échelle, de la zone entière. Par la suite, la lutte contre le paludisme revêtait un aspect décisif au traitement par le quinine s'agissant l'émission de Q.D.T. qui offrait, grâce à son effet de très longue durée, son prix de revient assez bas, son application relativement facile, la possibilité de déclencher une offensive efficace contre la mosquée adulte, propagateur du paludisme.

L'Organisation Mondiale de la Santé, par ses chercheurs, ses équipes de médecins qui s'efforcent de pénétrer au plus profond des régions concernées, étend ainsi remporter une grande victoire pacifique : ne générale pas présenter comme un bilan très honorable les résultats acquis en Europe? Alors qu'il y avait encore il n'y a pas très longtemps des zones réduites — au Portugal, en Espagne et surtout dans la vallée romaine de Cinisio — l'année 1962 marque une étape la disparition totale en Europe de la moustique.
C'est un exemple et un encouragement pour les autres continents.

LUTTE CONTRE LE PALUDISME

Nombreux sont ceux qui, conseillant pour en avoir entendu parler, ou mal terrible qu'est le MALARIA, mais peu sont ceux qui en ont une connaissance approximative et savent qu'elle est une maladie répandue non seulement dans les pays tropicaux et subtropicaux où le climat chaud et humide favorise le développement de cette moutarde sapide mais aussi en Europe et en particulier dans les pays du bassin méditerranéen et même de l'Europe centrale, Hongrie, Pologne, Russie européenne; en Italie elle se manifeste dans la vallée du Pô et dans les régions septentrionales et centrales. Le paludisme est dû à un parasite du sang, qui se transmet d'un homme à un autre par la piqûre d'un moustique femelle, l'Anophele. Ce mode de transmission explique le caractère insidieux de la maladie: de nouvelles générations de parasites sont pratiquement introduites dans le sang.

Le paludisme n'est pas une maladie spectaculaire: pas de pleurs, pas de mutilations ou d'infirmités. L'épisode commence par un grand frisson, les dents claquent, le corps est secoué de mouvements convulsifs, le moutarde vomit; sa peau est glacée mais sa température monte à 40° après le frisson venant à l'heure tâche, le souffle inextinguible, les bourdonnements dans le tête, le délire, enfin, la fièvre, le lit trempe, la température qui tombe et le soulagement du sommeil... jusqu'à la prochaine attaque... et, à la longue, un état pernicieux d'énorme souvent mortel.

La lutte contre le paludisme débute il y a des siècles. Le premier remède efficace fut la quinine découverte. Les moustiques Anophèles ne fut décelé que beaucoup plus tard. Grâce au DDT, découvert en 1939 la campagne d'éradication sur une grande échelle est devenue possible sous la direction et la responsabilité de l'Organisation Mondiale de la Santé (O.M.S.). Elle apportera la santé, la fertilité, la prospérité et le renouveau social de nombreuses régions du monde.
