Cyprus Malaria Eradication Commemorative Issue A special issue of postage stamps is being prepared for the Government of Cyprus to commemorate the World Malaria Eradication Campaign. Further details will be announced in a later edition of the Bulletin.

Cyprus New Definitive Issue The Aspioti-Elka Graphic Arts Co. Ltd. of Athens, Greece, are preparing a new definitive issue for the Government of Cyprus. Further details will be announced in a later edition of the Bulletin.

Federation of Malaya Malaria Eradication Commemorative Issue Messrs. Harrison & Sons Ltd., are preparing a special issue of three values to commemorate the World Malaria Eradication Campaign. The stamps will be printed on Malaya P.T.M. watermarked paper. Further details will be announced in a later edition of the Bulletin.

Federation of Nigeria Heads of State The special issue to commemorate the meeting in Lagos of the Heads of African States was printed by Messrs. Harrison & Sons Ltd., on Nigeria watermarked paper.

Nigeria issues are not available from the Crown Agents.

Hong Kong Postal Centenary Commemorative Issue The special issue announced in Bulletin No. 239 of 1st April, 1961 is being printed by Messrs. Harrison & Sons Ltd., by the photogravure process: the values are 10, 20 and 50 cents. The stamps are in horizontal format, size 25 x 39 mm., perforation to perforation. The design which is common to all values includes a portrait of Her Majesty the Queen with the St. Edward's Crown and a reproduction of the Statue of Queen Victoria which is in Victoria Park in Causeway Bay. The colours are as follows:

- 10 cents Red and black
- 20 cents Blue and black
- 50 cents Drab-yellow and black

Sierra Leone Malaria Eradication Commemorative Issue Messrs. Bradbury, Wilkinson & Co. Ltd. are preparing a special issue of stamps on "SL" watermarked paper, to commemorate the World Malaria Eradication Campaign, on behalf of the Government of Sierra Leone. Further details will be announced in a later edition of the Bulletin.
