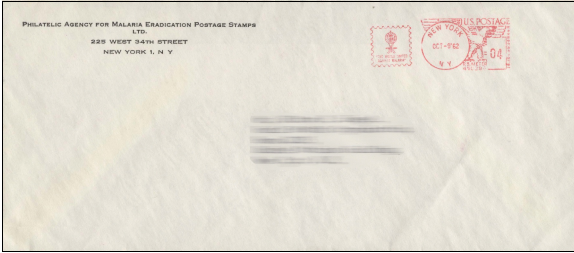

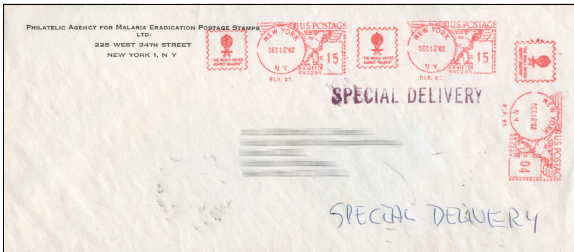

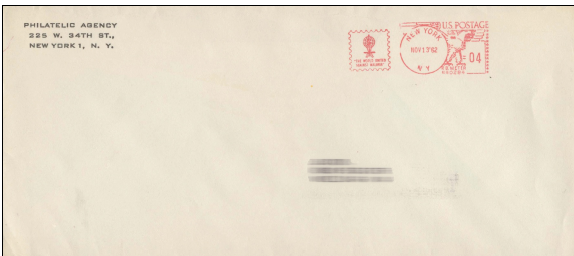

Your interest in the forthcoming Malaria Eradication Stamp Issues, sponsored by the World Health Organization, is much appreciated.

The Malaria Eradication Campaign of the WHO has been called "the greatest Health Campaign ever undertaken in the history of mankind." The Anti-Malaria stamps to be issued during 1962 by some 80 nations will play an important part in publicizing this important undertaking, as well as to contribute financially to its success. Therefore, these stamps stand for a deeply humanitarian cause, but at the same time are a historic philatelic event in that nations in every part of the world are issuing stamps under one slogan, - "The World united against Malaria".

Stamps and other philatelic items donated by the WHO by the participating governments will be distributed by this Agency to bona-fide stamp dealers in any part of the world, who will make them quickly and economically available to the individual collectors. In this fashion the best distribution will be achieved. We therefore recommend that you place a subscription for these issues with your favorite stamp dealer so that you may be assured of your supply.

We are keeping your name on file and will send you from time to time information bulletins and other material on the Malaria Eradication Campaign and on the stamp program.

We also recommend that you look for news items on the WHO stamps in the philatelic press. You will there also learn about various exhibitions to take place during 1962 dedicated to the theme of the Malaria Eradication stamps. Such exhibitions are being planned in various parts of the world, by philatelic societies, medical and health institutions etc. When a group known to you plans such an exhibition, this Agency should like to be informed and stands ready to support the enterprise.
