Commemorative issue

The General Post-Office of the D.R. Vietnam will release on July 9, 1962 a series of three stamps to mark the Malaria Eradication campaign. From the Malaria Eradication campaign planned for eight years (1958-1966) the period of studies and the first necessary steps of the fight been successfully carried out during the last four years. This year of 1962 is the first year of the second period and in the forthcoming four years the malaria will radically be wiped out from the D.R. Vietnam.
